9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE §§ 27-15-2701 AND 27-15-2702
10 TO ALLOW RETIRED FIRE FIGHTERS TO BE ISSUED A SPECIAL FIRE
11 FIGHTER'S MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE PLATE; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

16 ISSUED A SPECIAL FIRE FIGHTER'S MOTOR
17 VEHICLE LICENSE PLATE."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20
21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-15-2701 is amended to read as follows:
22 "27-15-2701. In general.

23 The Department of Finance and Administration shall, after seeking the
24 advice of the Fire Protection Services Board, design a special motor vehicle
25 license plate to be issued to active and retired certified fire fighters."

26
27 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-15-2702 is amended to read as follows:
28 "27-15-2702. Who is eligible - Fee - Renewal.

29 (a)(1) Any person who is certified by the Arkansas Fire Protection
30 Services Board of the State Office of Emergency Services as a certified fire
31 fighter or who has retired as a fire fighter shall be entitled to a special
32 fire fighter's motor vehicle license plate upon paying the normal fee plus ten
33 dollars (\$10.00) for the initial issuance of the license plate.

34 (2) The cost of the annual renewal shall be the normal fee only.

35 (b) Upon the annual renewal of the motor vehicle license plates issued
36 for passenger cars and Class One trucks, the active or retired fire fighter

1 shall provide adequate proof to the department that he is a certified fire
2 fighter or that he is a fire fighter retired from active service at the time
3 of applying for renewal."
4

5 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
6 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
7 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
8

9 SECTION 4. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
12 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
13 act are declared to be severable.
14

15 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
16 hereby repealed.
