17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-17-106 is repealed.

21 ~~— (a) Any person who shall abuse or insult a public school teacher while~~
