19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 26-26-1603 is amended to read as follows:	
22	"26-26-1603. Information to be furnished.	
23	$\underline{\text{(a)}}$ Each company, as defined in 6 26-26-1601, shall annually on or	
24	before March 1, make and deliver to the Tax Division of the Arkansas Public	
25	Service Commission, in such form as the division may prescribe, a statement-	,
26	<pre>under oath of the proper official, agent, or person of the company, showing</pre>	in
27	detail the following facts:	
28	(1) Name of company;	
29	(2) The status of the company, whether person, firm, company,	
30	copartnership, association, or corporation, and under the laws of what	
31	state or country organized or incorporated;	
32	(3) Location of its principal office within or without Arkansas;	
33	(4) Name and post office address of the owner, president,	
34	secretary, general manager, and agent having control of the company's	
35	affairs in this state;	

(5) The par value of all outstanding capital stock and funded

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1 debt of every kind, the market and, if no market, the actual value on

- 2 January 1 next preceding;
- 3 (6) The total gross revenues, expenses, net revenues, and net
- 4 income, separately, from utility operation, nonutility operation, and
- 5 nonoperating properties, for the next preceding calendar year, both
- 6 for the state of Arkansas and all states if the company operates in
- 7 states other than Arkansas, in which latter case Arkansas' stated
- 8 proportion of the total revenues, expenses, and income must include
- 9 not only revenues, expenses, and income arising from intrastate
- 10 business but also the state's due proportion of the revenues,
- 11 expenses, and income from interstate business;
- 12 (7) The total value of all real and personal property owned or
- 13 controlled by the company and situated outside of Arkansas on January
- 14 1 next preceding showing separately that part used in connection with
- 15 the daily operations of the company and that part used otherwise, if
- 16 there is any;
- 17 (8) A detailed statement of all real and personal property owned
- 18 or controlled by the company and situated in Arkansas on January 1
- 19 next preceding, giving the description, location, and value thereof,
- 20 and showing separately that part used in connection with the daily
- 21 operations of the company and that part used otherwise, if there is
- 22 any;
- 23 (9) Such other and additional information as to ownership,
- 24 amount, kind, location, operation, and value of property owned or
- 25 controlled as the division may require.
- 26 (b) The official, agent, or person of the company submitting the
- 27 required statement shall make and sign, on the face of the required statement,
- 28 the following declaration:
- I declare, under the penalties of perjury, that the foregoing
- 30 statements are true to the best of my knowledge and belief."

- 32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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36 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 4 act are declared to be severable.
