17	SECTION 1. Commercial Vehicle. A commercial vehicle as used herein i	_
18	defined as any private vehicle used to transport goods or persons for hire,	as
19	well as any vehicle operated by state government, or any agency or departmen	t
20	thereof, or any local government entity, including cities, counties, school	
21	districts, and improvement districts.

23	SECTION 2. With regard to commercial vehicles, no policy or bond shal	1
24	be effective under Arkansas Code 8 27-19-604 unless issued by an insurance	
25	company or surety company authorized to do business in this state, nor unles	S
26	the policy or bond is subject, if the accident resulted in bodily injury or	
27	death, to a limit, exclusive of interest and costs, of not less than one	
28	hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) because of bodily injury or death of one	
29	(1) person in any one (1) accident and subject to said limit for one (1)	
30	person in any one (1) accident and subject to said limit for one (1) person,	
31	to a limit of not less than three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) becaus	e
32	of bodily injury or death of two (2) or more persons in any one (1) accident	<u>,</u>
33	and if the accident has resulted in injury to or destruction of property, to	
34	limit of not less than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) because of injury to	
35	or destruction of property of others in any one (1) accident.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 3 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 4 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 7 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 8 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 9 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 10 act are declared to be severable. SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 13 hereby repealed.
