22	SECTION 1. This Act	may be cited as the "General Imp	rovement	
23	Distribution Act of 1997".			
24				
25	SECTION 2. There is	hereby created and established o	n the books of	the
26	Chief Fiscal Officer of th	e State, the State Treasurer and	the State Audi	tor,
27	the "81st Session Projects	Account" within the "General Imp	rovement Fund"	,
28	into which shall be transf	erred and credited the respective	monies as	
29	hereinafter provided in th	is Act, to be used for providing	financing, in	the
30	manner set forth herein, f	or the various projects and purpo	ses enumerated	in
31	this Act to be financed fr	om said account.		
32	Immediately upon the	e effective date of this Act, or a	s soon thereaf	ter
33	as is practical, the State	Treasurer shall transfer and cre	dit to the "81	st
34	Session Projects Account"	of the "General Improvement Fund"	, upon	
35	certification of the amoun	ts thereof by the Chief Fiscal Of	ficer of the S	tate,
36	the following:			

(a) all unobligated and unallocated monies remaining in the "General

2 Improvement Fund" which are not required to finance projects to be financed 3 therefrom pursuant to appropriations enacted by the 80th General Assembly, or 4 which have not been reappropriated or reallocated for financing from the 5 "General Improvement Fund" by the 81st General Assembly; (b) any unobligated or unallocated funds remaining in the "General 7 Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund" from monies accruing thereto during the 1995-8 97 fiscal biennium which are not required to finance enactments of the 81st 9 General Assembly that do not expire on June 30, 1997 and after providing for 10 the transfer to the Balanced Budget Reserve Fund, as may be authorized by law; 11 and 12 (c) interest earned on State Treasury fund balances as provided in 13 this subsection. For the period commencing on July 1, 1997, and ending June 14 30, 1999, the State Treasurer shall, after complying with provisions of (1) Arkansas Code $^{\circ}27-70-204$ for distributing interest income 15 16 earned from investment of average daily balances of the "State Highway and 17 Transportation Department Fund", (2) Arkansas Code 15-41-110 for distributing interest earned 18 19 from investment of average daily balances of the "Game Protection Fund", (3) Arkansas Code 15-5-422 for the first two million dollars 20 21 (\$2,000,000) of interest income received each fiscal year by the State 22 Treasurer as authorized for the Correction Facilities Construction Fund, and (4) Arkansas Code $^{\circ}20-78-504$ for the next one hundred thousand 23 24 dollars (\$100,000) of interest income received each fiscal year by the State

26 credit to the "Budget Stabilization Trust Fund" or its successor fund, fifty
27 percent (50%) of the interest income received and credited to the "Securities

25 Treasurer for the Arkansas Child Care Facilities Loan Guarantee Trust Fund,

28 Reserve Fund", and credit to the "81st Session Projects Account" fifty percent

29 (50%) of the interest income received and credited to the "Securities Reserve

30 Fund" as certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to provide

31 financing to the "81st Session Projects Account", until there has been

32 credited an amount, which when added to the other funds available for such

33 purposes will finance each of the projects or purposes hereinafter enumerated.

34

35 SECTION 3. (A) Of those moneys accruing to the 81 Session Projects 36 Account of the General Improvement Fund as set out in Section 2 of this Act,

1 fifty percent (50%) shall be allocated in order to provide financing for those

- 2 projects enumerated in Section 5 of this Act, and the remaining fifty percent
- 3 (50%) shall be allocated to provide financing for those projects as set out in
- 4 Section 4 of this Act.
- 5 (B) After all of the projects enumerated in Section 5 of this Act have
- 6 been financed pursuant to the provisions of this section, as certified by the
- 7 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and notification to the Legislative Council,
- 8 those additional monies accruing to the 81st Session Projects Account of the
- 9 General Improvement Fund as set out in Section 2(a),(b) and (c) of this Act
- 10 shall be allocated in order to provide financing for those projects enumerated
- 11 in Section 4 of this Act.
- 12 (C) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall determine the
- 13 difference obtained by subtracting the sum of the projects enumerated in
- 14 Section 5 of this Act from the funds to be available to finance such projects
- 15 as set out in this section. If it is determined that there will not be
- 16 sufficient funds available to finance the projects in Section 5 herein, the
- 17 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer from the Economic Development
- 18 of Arkansas Fund an amount sufficent to provide for the full financing of
- 19 those projects.

- 21 SECTION 4. EXECUTIVE ALLOCATIONS. (A) From the monies accruing to the
- 22 benefit of the 81st Session Projects Account of the General Improvement
- 23 Fund as authorized by Section 3 of this Act, the Governor may direct the
- 24 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to effectuate an allocation of monies for
- 25 financing certain appropriation and transfers of monies as authorized by the
- 26 81 General Assembly as follows:
