9 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL MOTOR
10 VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES FOR VEHICLES OF MEMBERS OF THE
11 ARMED FORCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "TO PROVIDE FOR ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL
15 LICENSE PLATES FOR VEHICLES OWNED BY
16 MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19
20 SECTION 1. Title 27, Chapter 15 of the Arkansas Code is amended by
21 adding a new subchapter at the end of the chapter to read as follows:

22 "(a) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
23 issue special license plates, upon application, to members of the Armed Forces
24 who have received an honorable discharge. The special license plates shall be
25 the same design as the standard license plate as is currently being issued,
26 except that in lieu of the legend 'The Natural State', or a subsequent legend,
27 the license plates shall have a permanent decal affixed bearing the name of
28 the division of the Armed Forces of which the applicant is a member.

29 (b) Any member who has received an honorable discharge from the Armed
30 Forces may make applications for, and receive special license plates for
31 automobiles and Class One (1) trucks and vans owned by the applicant. The fee
32 for each special license plate shall be the regular registration fee for the
33 vehicle being registered, plus an additional five dollars (\$5.00) annually to
34 partially defray the cost of administering the Special License Plates Program.

35 (c) The additional five dollars (\$5.00) shall be deposited as direct
36 revenues into the State Central Services Fund for the support of the Revenue

1 Division of the Department of Finance and Administration.

2 (d) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
3 promulgate such rules and regulations as are necessary to carry out the
4 provisions of this subchapter."

5

6 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
7 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
8 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

9

10 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
11 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
12 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
13 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
14 act are declared to be severable.

15

16 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
17 hereby repealed.
