28	SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by				
29	this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made				
30	available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions				
31	of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures

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2 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 3 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 4 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 5 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 7 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 8 9 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

15 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application 16 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall 17 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given 18 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the 19 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

21 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with 22 this act are hereby repealed.

24 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 25 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that 26 27 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of 28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 29 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 30 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the 31 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 32 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 33 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 34 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999. 35

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
