16	"AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF WORLD WAR II
17	VETERAN, KOREAN WAR VETERAN, VIETNAM VETERAN, AND
18	PERSIAN GULF VETERAN LICENSE PLATES; AND FOR OTHER
19	PURPOSES. "

21	Subtitle
22	"AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF
23	WORLD WAR II VETERAN, KOREAN WAR
24	VETERAN, VIETNAM VETERAN, AND PERSIAN
25	GULF VETERAN LICENSE PLATES."

27	
28	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
29	
30	SECTION 1. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration
31	shall provide for and issue special World War II Veteran license plates,
32	special Korean War Veteran license plates, special Vietnam Veteran license
33	plates, and special Persian Gulf Veteran license plates. The license plates
34	shall be issued in the manner and subject to the conditions prescribed in thi
35	<u>act.</u>

1	SECTION 2. The license plates shall be of standard color and design as
2	is currently issued by the Department of Finance and Administration, except
3	that, in lieu of the legend "The Natural State" or any succeeding legend, the
4	license plates shall have placed across the bottom thereof a permanent decal
5	bearing the words "World War II Veteran", "Korean War Veteran", "Vietnam
6	<u>Veteran"</u> , or "Persian Gulf Veteran".
7	
8	SECTION 3. Upon payment of the fee required by law for registration of
9	the vehicle, payment of an additional ten dollar (\$10.00) handling and
10	administrative fee for the issuance of a special license plate, and
11	presentation of proof of being eligible for a special license plate, the
12	Department of Finance and Administration shall issue the appropriate special
13	license plate to the vehicle owner. The handling and administrative fee of
14	ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be deposited in the State Central Services Fund for
15	the benefit of the Revenue Division and shall be credited to the Revenue
16	Division as supplemental and in addition to all other funds as may be
17	deposited for the benefit of the Revenue Division. The handling and
18	administrative fee shall not be considered or credited to the Revenue Division
19	as "direct revenues".
20	
21	SECTION 4. Special license plates issued under this act may be renewed
22	annually at the regular fee. Registration may continue from year to year as
23	long as it is renewed each year within the time and manner required by law.
24	
25	SECTION 5. Special license plates issued under this act may be
26	transferred from one vehicle to another pursuant to Arkansas Code § 27-14-914.
27	
28	SECTION 6. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration
29	shall promulgate such reasonable rules and regulations and prescribe such
30	forms as he determines to be necessary for effectively and efficiently
31	carrying out the intent and purposes of this act.
32	
33	SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
34	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
35	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

1	SECTION 8. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
2	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
3	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
4	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
5	act are declared to be severable.
6	
7	SECTION 9. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
8	hereby repeal ed.
