regulation pertaining to, or regulate in any other manner, the ownership,
 transfer, transportation, carrying, or possession of firearms, ammunition for
 firearms, or components of firearms, except as otherwise provided in state or
 federal law. This shall not prevent the enactment of an ordinance regulating
 or forbidding the unsafe discharge of a firearm.

(2) A local unit of government shall have no authority to bring 6 7 suit and shall have no right to recover against any firearm or ammunition manufacturer, trade association, or dealer for damages, abatement, or 8 9 injunctive relief resulting from or relating to the lawful design, manufacture, marketing, or sale of firearms or ammunition to the public. The 10 authority to bring any suit and the right to recover against any firearm or 11 12 ammunition manufacturer, trade association, or dealer for damages, abatement, 13 or injunctive relief shall be reserved exclusively to the State of Arkansas. Provided, this shall not prevent a local unit of government from bringing suit 14 15 against a firearm or ammunition manufacturer or dealer for breach of contract 16 or warranty as to firearms or ammunition purchased by the local unit of 17 government. 18 (c) Notwithstanding subsection (b) of this section, the governing body

of a local unit of government may, following the proclamation by the Governor of a state of emergency, enact an emergency ordinance regulating the transfer, transportation, or carrying of firearms, or components of firearms. Such emergency ordinance shall not be effective for a period of more than twenty (20) days and shall be enacted by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the governing body."

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26 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-54-1411 is amended to read as follows:
27 "14-54-1411. Firearms and ammunition.

28 (a) As used in this section, 'local unit of government' means a city,29 town, or county.

30 (b)(1) A local unit of government shall not enact any ordinance or 31 regulation pertaining to, or regulate in any other manner, the ownership, 32 transfer, transportation, carrying, or possession of firearms, ammunition for 33 firearms, or components of firearms, except as otherwise provided in state or 34 federal law. This shall not prevent the enactment of an ordinance regulating 35 or forbidding the unsafe discharge of a firearm.

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(2) A local unit of government shall have no authority to bring

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suit and shall have no right to recover against any firearm or ammunition 1 2 manufacturer, trade association, or dealer for damages, abatement, or 3 injunctive relief resulting from or relating to the lawful design, manufacture, marketing, or sale of firearms or ammunition to the public. The 4 authority to bring any suit and the right to recover against any firearm or 5 ammunition manufacturer, trade association, or dealer for damages, abatement, 6 7 or injunctive relief shall be reserved exclusively to the State of Arkansas.
