19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-1-104(a)(2) pertaining to miscellaneous
22 penalties for election law violations is amended to read as follows:

23 "(2) No public official or ~~deputy responsible for registration~~ person
24 shall in any manner willfully or corruptly permit any person not entitled to
25 register for the purpose of voting to do so; or forge a registration or
26 attempt to do so;"

27
28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31
32 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
34 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
36 Act are declared to be severable.
