17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-5-201(b) is amended to read as follows:

20 "(b) Residency shall generally be that place where one lives ~~and works~~
21 ~~for a period of time~~, notwithstanding that there may be an intent to move or
22 return at some future date to another place. Persons who are temporarily
23 living in a particular place because of a temporary work-related assignment or
24 duty post, or as a result of their performing duties in connection with their
25 status as military personnel, students, or office holders, shall be deemed
26 residents of that place where they established their home prior to beginning
27 such assignments or duties."

28
29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
35 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 Act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
4 hereby repealed.
