" 17 18 19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-5-311(a) is amended to read as follows: 21 22 "(a) The county boards of election commissioners and the county 23 committees of the respective political parties with respect to general, special, and primary elections under their several jurisdictions shall provide 24 voting locations which are accessible to disabled voters and shall provide 25 reasonable and adequate methods whereby disabled voters may personally and 26 27 secretly execute their ballots at the polling places." 28 29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 7-5-311(e) is amended to read as follows: "(e)(1) The county board of election commissioners shall be responsible 30 31 for compliance with this section and with Public Law 98-435 and Title II of Public Law 101-336, the Americans with Disabilities Act, regarding the 32 accessibility of voting locations for disabled voters, except that county 33 political parties shall be responsible for compliance with this section and 34 with Public Law 98-435 for primary elections. 35 36 (2) The Secretary of State shall provide the chairman of each

3	(3) The Secretary of State shall send the copies by certified
4	mail."

6	SECTION 3. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
7	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
8	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
9	
10	SECTION 4. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
11	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
12	other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
13	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
14	Act are declared to be severable.
15	
16	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
17	hereby repealed.
