25	cause a notice of decedent's death and the filing of an affidavit for

27	(B) The notice shall contain:	
28	(i) The name of the decedent and his or her last	
29	known address;	
30	(ii) The date of death;	
31	(iii) A statement that the affidavit was filed, th	
32	date of the filing, and a legal description of all real property listed in	the

34	(iv) A statement requiring all persons having clai	
35	against the estate to exhibit them, properly verified, within six (6) three	_
36	(3) months from the date of the first publication of the notice, or they sl	nall

1	be forever barred and precluded from any benefit in the estate;
2	(v) The name and mailing address of the distributee
3	or his attorney; and
4	(vi) The date the notice was first published.
5	(C) Publication of the notice shall be as provided in §§
6	28-1-112(b)(4) and 28-40-111(a)(4)."

8	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
9	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
10	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
11	
12	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
13	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
14	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
15	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
16	act are declared to be severable.
17	
18	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
19	hereby repealed.
