15 2001; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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28 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
29 University of Arkansas at Monticello for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following
30 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
31 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
32 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
33 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
34 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
35 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
36 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular

1 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
 2 successor.

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12 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the University
 13 of Arkansas at Monticello, to be payable from the *General Improvement Fund or*
 14 *its successor fund or fund accounts* for personal services and operating
 15 expenses of a *Spatial Information Systems Bachelor Degree Program and an*
 16 *Associate of Science Degree Program in Surveying Technology, which are hereby*
 17 *created, for the University of Arkansas at Monticello - for the biennial*
 18 *period ending June 30, 2001, the following:*

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32 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
 33 this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
 34 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
 35 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
 36 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and

1 Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their
2 successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and
3 regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as
4 authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said
5 funds.

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7 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
8 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
9 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act
10 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
11 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
12 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
13 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
14 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
17 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
18 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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20 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application
21 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
22 not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given
23 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
24 provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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26 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
27 this Act are hereby repealed.

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29 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
30 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
31 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
32 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
34 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
35 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
36 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.

1 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
2 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
3 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
