## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A TOLL CALLING PLAN IN EXCHANGES WI th Customers who are unable to call the county seat WI THOUT MAKING A TOLL CALL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

an act to establish a toll calling plan IN EXCHANGES WITH CUSTOMERS WHO ARE
unable to call the county seat without MAKING A TOLL CALL.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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SECTION 1. (a) The customers in any exchange of an eligible telecommunications carrier in Arkansas who cannot make a telephone call to a telephone number in a county seat within the county in which the customer is located without making a tol|cal| shal| receive a special tol|cal|ing plan and every access I ine within the exchange shal| receive the plan.
(b)(1) The calling plan shall provide sixty (60) minutes per monthly billing cycle of toll free calling within the Local Access Transport Area. (2) To assist in paying for the plan, a fee of one dollar
(\$1.00) per monthly billing cycle shall be added to the customer bill for
each access line.
(c)(1) The plan shall be provided by eligible telecommunications
carriers within the exchange that provide basic local exchange service to the
access lines.

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            (2) The eligible telecommunications carrier may provide the plan
through its own facilities or may provide the plan through an agreement with
another certified carrier.
    (d) The eligible telecommunications carrier shall not owe any Arkansas
intraLATA carrier common line pool charges on any mi nutes of use in the plan.
    (e)(1)(A) The eligible telecommunications carrier shall receive eight
cents (8C) per minute of use for all minutes used in the plan from the
Arkansas Universal Service Fund.
    (B)(i) Upon demonstrating additional costs for providing
the plan the Arkansas Public Service Commi ssion may increase the rate based
on the demonstrated costs.
    (ii) The increase may be on a state-wide basis or
may be on a company-wide basis upon application by the company and
demonstration of the need.
                    (iii) The rate shall be set at an amount to pay all
costs associated with the plan and an additional one cent (1d) per mi nute
above the cost per mi nute of use.
    (2)(A) The Arkansas Universal Service Fund shall reimburse the
eligible telecommunications carrier on a monthly basis, paid three (3) months
in arrears, for the amount the eligible telecommunications carrier is
entitled to receive under this subsection (e).
    (B) The toll call plan shall not be used to decrease other
rei mbursement from the Arkansas Universal Service Fund.
    (3) The eligible telecommunications carrier shall be obligated
to pay all access charges and other expenses incurred from the amount it is
entitled to receive under this subsection (e).
    (f) The Arkansas Public Service Commi ssion shall administer this act
and shall promulgate rules and regulations on an expedited basis as needed to
implement and administer the plan.
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
