1 it being the intent of this chapter that the principal amount of the Trust 2 Fund should not be appropriated without amendment of this public trust. The principal amount of the Arkansas Healthy Century Trust Fund may also be used 3 for transfers to the General Revenue Fund Account for the fiscal year ending 4 June 30, 2002 as provided elsewhere by law. 5 6 7 SECTION 3. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, or as soon thereafter as is practical, and after certification of the amounts by the 8 9 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the State Treasurer shall transfer and 10 credit to the General Revenue Fund Account of the State Apportionment Fund as 11 general revenues available for distribution as provided in A.C.A. 19-5-202 (b) (2)(B)(iii), the sum of fifty-six million dollars (\$56,000,000) from the 12 13 Arkansas Healthy Century Trust Fund. 14 15 SECTION 4. The funds transferred under the provisions of this Act 16 shall be supplemental an in addition to the general revenues available for distribution to the various general revenue funds and fund accounts in 17 18 accordance with the allocations established in A.C.A. 19-5-401 - 402 for the 19 fiscal year ending June 30, 2002. 20 21 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 22 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the general revenues of the State of 23 Arkansas have significantly decreased as a result of distressed economic conditions; that adequate funds are available in the Arkansas Healthy Century 24 25 Trust Fund for the purpose of maintaining necessary state programs and 26 services; that this bill provides a mechanism for necessary fund transfers during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002. Therefore, and emergency is 27 declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the 28 29 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on 30 the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become <u>effective on the expiration of</u> 31 the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill 32 33 is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto. 34

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
