19	AS THE GENERAL REVENUE FORECAST FOR THE

21	ONE HUNDRED AND TWO AND ONE-HALF PERCENT
22	(102.5%) OF THE ACTUAL GENERAL REVENUE

26	WHEREAS, the several reductions in general revenue forecasts during the
27	current fiscal year have demonstrated that the forecasts upon which the
28	general revenue appropriations were based during the 2001 Regular Session
29	were unrealistic and have not materialized; and
30	WHEREAS, the result is that this Special Session of the General
31	Assembly has been called to quickly reallocate funds to address the current
32	general revenue shortfall; and
33	WHEREAS, in order to prevent a recurrence of what has happened during
34	the current fiscal year, it is imperative that the general revenue forecast
35	utilized during the next fiscal year be as realistic as possible;

7	requested and urged to use as the general revenue forecast for the 2002-2003
8	fiscal year, an amount equal to one hundred and two and one-half percent
9	(102.5%) of the actual general revenue receipts by the State of Arkansas
10	during the 2001-2002 fiscal year.
