19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-6-407 is amended to read as follows:

22 8-6-407. ~~Commercial refuse~~ Refuse hauling by uncovered vehicles.

23 It shall be unlawful for any person ~~engaged in commercial or for hire~~
24 ~~hauling~~ to operate any truck or other vehicle within this state to transport
25 litter, trash, or garbage unless the vehicle is covered to prevent its
26 contents from blowing, dropping, falling off, or otherwise departing from the
27 vehicle. ~~In addition, any person operating his own truck or other vehicle to~~
28 ~~transport litter, trash, or garbage shall take reasonable steps to prevent~~
29 ~~its contents from blowing, dropping, falling off, or otherwise departing from~~
30 ~~the vehicle.~~ However, no vehicle hauling predominately metallic material
31 shall be required to be covered if it is loaded in a manner which will
32 prevent the material from falling or dropping from the vehicle.
