23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-101-203, concerning the equipment			
24	requirements for motorboats, is amended to add the following new subsection:			
25	(e)(1)(A) No person shall operate a motorboat equipped by the			
26	manufacturer with a lanyard-type engine cutoff switch while the engine is			
27	used to propel the boat without attaching the lanyard to the operator, the			
28	operator's clothing, or if worn to the operator's personal flotation device			
29	as appropriate for the specific vessel.			
30	(B) However, if a motorboat equipped with a lanyard-type			
31	switch is a house boat, a pontoon boat, or is traveling less than five (5)			
32	miles per hour, the lanyard shall not be required to be attached to the			
33	operator, the operator's clothing, or to the operator's personal flotation

35		(2) As used in this subsection, "lanyard-type engine cutoff		
36	switch" means an emergency engine or motor shut-off switch that attaches by a			

1	lanyard to the person operating the motorboat and the switch is constructe		
2	and installed in a manner so that when in use, if the operator falls		
3	overboard or is removed from the normal operating station of the boat, the		
4	the switch will immediately shut-off of the boat's engine or motor.		
5	(3) This subsection (e) does not apply to flat bottomed boats
