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1	27-15-3902. Design.
2	(a)(1) The special "Choose Life" motor vehicle license plates shall be
3	designed by Choose Life, Inc. and the design shall be submitted to the
4	Director of the Department of Finance and Administration for design approval.
5	(2) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration
6	shall have the final authority for the design approval and the issuance to
7	any person of the "Choose Life" license plate.
8	(3) The purpose of the special license plate is for a person to
9	support organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
10	with unplanned pregnancies.
11	(b)(1) Before the license plate is issued, there shall be remitted to
12	the Department of Finance and Administration a fee in the amount of $\underline{six}$
13	thousand dollars (\$6,000) to cover the cost of the initial order of each
14	newly designed license plate.
15	(2) This fee shall be deposited to the State Central Services
16	Fund for the benefit of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and
17	Administration and shall be credited as supplemental and in addition to all
18	other funds as may be deposited for the benefit of the division.
19	(3) The fee shall not be considered or credited to the division
20	as direct revenues.
21	(4) The fee amount may be paid by any person, organization, or
22	by any combination of persons or organizations.
23	
24	<u>27-15-3903. Fees.</u>
25	(a) Upon payment of the fee required by law for the registration of
26	the vehicle, payment of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) to cover the design use
27	contribution, and payment of an additional ten dollars (\$10.00) handling and
28	administrative fee for the issuance of the special "Choose Life" license
29	plate, the Department of Finance and Administration shall issue to the
30	vehicle owner a "Choose Life" license plate which shall bear the approved
31	<u>design.</u>
32	(b)(1)(A) The handling and administrative fee of ten dollars (\$10.00)
33	shall be deposited to the State Central Services Fund for the benefit of the
34	Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration.
35	(B) The fee shall not be considered or credited to the
36	division as direct revenues.

1	(2) The design use contribution of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)
2	shall be deposited as special revenues in the "State Treasury."
3	
4	27-15-3904. "Choose Life" Adoption Assistance Program Fund.
5	(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the
6	Auditor of State and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a special revenue
7	fund to be known as the "Choose Life" Adoption Assistance Program Fund.
8	(b)(1) All moneys collected as design use contributions under § 27-15-
9	3903 shall be deposited as special revenues as follows:
10	(A) Two percent (2%) in the Public Health Fund to be used
11	by the Arkansas Department of Health for administrative services for the
12	program; and
13	(B) Ninety-eight percent (98%) to the "Choose Life"
14	Adoption Assistance Program Fund to be used by the Arkansas Department of
15	Health for distribution to nonprofit organizations under this subchapter.
16	(2) The Director of the Arkansas Department of Health shall distribute
17	the funds to qualified organizations that provide services to the community
18	that include counseling and meeting the physical needs of pregnant women who
19	are committed to placing their children for adoption.
20	(3) All moneys accruing to the credit of the "Choose Life"
21	Adoption Assistance Program Fund shall be appropriated and shall be
22	distributed at the beginning of each fiscal year in a pro rata share to all
23	qualified organizations.
24	(4) Any unused funds in excess of ten percent (10%) of the funds
25	allocated to a nonprofit organization shall be returned to the "Choose Life"
26	Adoption Assistance Program Fund at the end of the fiscal year to be
27	aggregated and distributed with the next fiscal year distribution.
28	(c) To qualify to receive the funds available through the "Choose
29	Life" Adoption Assistance Program, an organization shall deliver to the
30	Department of Health an affidavit signed by a representative of the
31	organization that states the organization:
32	(1) Is a nonprofit organization;
33	(2) Does not discriminate because of race, marital status,
34	gender, religion, national origin, handicap or age;
35	(3) Counsels pregnant women about the option of placing their
36	children for adoption;

1	(4) Is not involved or associated in any way with any abortion
2	activities, including counseling for or referrals to abortion clinics,
3	providing medical abortion-related procedures, or pro-abortion advertising;
4	(5) Does not charge women for any services received;
5	(6) Will use the funds received only for the purposes and under
6	the restrictions of subsection (d) of this section, will use none of the
7	funds for administrative expenses, legal expenses, or capital expenditures;
8	(7) Will return at the end of each fiscal year any unused funds
9	exceeding ten percent (10%) of the funds received; and
10	(8) Will submit to an annual audit of the funds received.
11	(d)(1)(A) Funds shall not be distributed to any organization that is
12	involved or associated with abortion activities, including counseling for or
13	referral to abortion clinics, providing medical abortion-related procedures,
14	or pro-abortion advertising.
15	(B) Funds shall not be distributed to any organization
16	that charges women for services received.
17	(2)(A) Sixty percent (60%) of the funds received by an
18	organization may be used only to provide for the material needs of pregnant
19	women who are committed to placing their children for adoption or expended on
20	infants awaiting placement with adoptive parents.
21	(B) The material needs of pregnant women shall include
22	clothing, housing, medical care, food, utilities, and transportation.
23	(3) Forty percent (40%) of the funds may be used only for
24	adoption, counseling, training, or advertising, but shall not be used for
25	administrative expenses, legal expenses, or capital expenditures.
26	(e) Within six (6) months of the end of the fiscal year, an
27	organization that received and used funds during a fiscal year shall submit
28	an audit report of the funds received to the Director of the Arkansas
29	Department of Health verifying that the funds received were used in the
30	manner prescribed in this subchapter.
31	
32	27-15-3905. Renewal.
33	(a)(1) The special "Choose Life" license plate issued under this
34	subchapter may be renewed annually under the procedures in § 27-15-3903 and
35	under §§ 27-14-1012 and 27-14-1013.
36	(2) Registration may continue from year to year as long as it is

1	renewed each year within the time and manner required by law.		
2	(b) A motor vehicle owner who was previously issued a plate with the		
3	"Choose Life" design authorized by this subchapter and who does not pay a		
4	design use contribution of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) at the subsequent		
5	time of registration shall be issued a new plate which does not bear the		
6	"Choose Life" design.		
7	(c) Upon expiration or if the special "Choose Life" license plate is		
8	lost, the plate may be replaced with a regular license plate at the fee		
9	specified in § 27-14-602(b)(6).		
10	(d) If the special "Choose Life" license plate is replaced with a new		
11	"Choose Life" license plate, the owner shall be required to pay the fees for		
12	the issuance of the license plate under § 27-15-3903.		
13			
14	27-15-3906. Transfer to another vehicle.		
15	The special "Choose Life" license plate issued under this subchapter		
16	may be transferred from one vehicle to another as provided in § 27-14-914.		
17			
18	27-15-3907. Compliance with other laws.		
19	The special "Choose Life" license plate shall comply with:		
20	(1) The minimum number of license plate applications required under §		
21	<u>27-15-4004;</u>		
22	(2) All other state motor vehicle laws relating to registration and		
23	licensing of motor vehicles, unless specifically provided otherwise in this		
24	subchapter.

26	27-15-3908. Rules and regulations.		
27	The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall		
28	promulgate reasonable rules and regulations and prescribe forms as the		
29	director determines to be necessary for effectively and efficiently carrying		
30	out the intent and purposes of this subchapter.
