17	(2) Deposit any gifts, grants, bequests, devises, and donations

2	(a) Baby Sharon's Children's Catastrophic Illness Grant Program Trust

6	Department of Finance and Administration to accept gifts, grants, bequests,
7	devises, and donations shall be effective on August 1, 2003.

9	26-35-1205. Advisory committee.
10	(a) There is established an advisory committee to be known as the
11	"Baby Sharon's Children's Catastrophic Illness Grant Program Advisory
12	<u>Committee".</u>
13	(b) The committee shall consist of five (5) members to be appointed by
14	the Governor.
15	(c) The committee members shall be:
16	(1) Individuals who have knowledge of children with catastrophic
17	illnesses or injuries; and
18	(2) Residents of the State of Arkansas at the time of
19	appointment and throughout his or her term.
20	(d)(1) Except for initial appointments, the appointments to the

22	(b)(1) All moneys collected under § 26-35-1202 shall be deposited into
23	the State Treasury to the credit of the fund.
24	(2) The fund shall also consist of any other revenues as may be

26	(c) The fund shall be used exclusively by the Department of Human
27	Services to assist with the medical expenses incurred by the families of
28	children with catastrophic illnesses or injuries by awarding grants to the
29	families who are liable for the medical expenses.
30	(d) The Treasurer of State shall credit to the fund the amount
31	certified each quarter in accordance with § 26-35-1203.
32	(e)(1) The moneys credited to the fund shall be held as trust funds in
33	interest-bearing accounts only.
34	(2) All interest earned shall be credited to the fund and shall
35	be used only for the purposes of the fund.
36	(f) All moneys deposited into the fund and all interest earned on

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1	deposits and the fund balance in the fund may be disbursed as appropriated in
2	each fiscal year of the biennium for Baby Sharon's Children's Catastrophic
3	Illness Grant Program.

5	SECTION 3. (a) The Department of Human Services shall use funds from
6	"Baby Sharon's Children's Catastrophic Illness Grant Program Trust Fund" to
7	establish Baby Sharon's Children's Catastrophic Illness Grant Program.
8	(b) The department shall promulgate rules and regulations to create a
9	grant program that assists families of children with catastrophic illnesses
10	or injuries with medical expenses for which the families are liable.
11	(c) The department shall consult with Baby Sharon's Children's
12	Catastrophic Illness Grant Program Advisory Committee concerning:
13	(1) Grant applications related to Baby Sharon's Children's
14	Catastrophic Illness Grant Program; and
15	(2) Rules and regulations promulgated by the department for Baby
16	Sharon's Children's Catastrophic Illness Grant Program.
