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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-11-105 is amended to read as follows:	
6-11-105. Powers and duties.	
(a) The State Board of Education shall:	
(1) Have general supervision of the public schools of the stat	e;
(2) Prepare and distribute plans and specifications for the	
construction and equipment of school buildings and approve plans and	
expenditures of public school funds for all new school buildings;	
(3) Recommend courses of study for the public schools and	
teacher training institutions;  (4) Prescribe rules and regulations for the sanitary inspection	n
(4) Prescribe rules and regulations for the sanitary inspections of all buildings and for the examination of pupils to detect contagious and	

1	infectious diseases and physical defects;
2	(5) Issue certificates based upon credentials presented by
3	applicants for certificates to teach in the public schools of the state;
4	(6) Qualify and standardize public schools and prescribe
5	requirements for accrediting and grading public schools;
6	(7) Supervise the operation of school district budgets;
7	(8) Supervise the purchase and distribution of textbooks;
8	(9) Take such other action as it may deem necessary to promote
9	the physical welfare of school children and promote the organization and
10	increase the efficiency of the public schools of the state; and
11	(10) Perform all other functions which may now or hereafter be
12	delegated to the board by law. However, nothing in this act shall prohibit
13	the board and the Department of Education from issuing teachers' certificates
14	upon the results of teachers' examinations as now provided by $law_{oldsymbol{ au}}$ ; and
15	(11)(A) Eliminate unnecessary reports and paperwork by yearly
16	identifying and compiling a list of all reports that are required from local
17	school districts by the Department of Education or the State Board of
