15 AN ACT TO MODIFY THE TERMS OF OFFICE FOR
16 MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS NATURAL AND
17 CULTURAL RESOURCES COUNCIL.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-12-101(a), regarding the creation of the
24 Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Council, is amended to read as
25 follows:

26 (a) There is established the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources
27 Council, which shall consist of eleven (11) voting members as follows:

- 28 (1) The Director of the Department of Parks and Tourism;
29 (2) The Director of the Department of Arkansas Heritage;
30 (3) The Chair of the State Parks, Recreation, and Travel
31 Commission or his or her designee;
32 (4) The Chair of the Arkansas Natural Heritage Commission or his
33 or her designee;
34 (5) The Commissioner of State Lands;
35 (6) Two (2) resident electors of this state as public members
36 who are representative of recreation groups, conservation groups, or other



1 groups interested in the wise use, preservation, and conservation of
2 Arkansas' natural or cultural resources;

3 (7) One (1) member to represent Arkansas cities and towns, to be
4 named by the Governor from a list of three (3) names recommended to the
5 Governor by the Arkansas Municipal League. ~~This member shall serve a term of
6 two (2) years or until his or her successor is appointed and qualified;~~

7 (8) One (1) member to represent Arkansas counties, who shall be
8 appointed by the Governor from a list of three (3) names submitted to the
9 Governor by the Arkansas County Judges Association. ~~This member shall serve
10 a term of two (2) years or until his or her successor is appointed and
11 qualified;~~

12 (9) One (1) member appointed by the Speaker of the House of
13 Representatives; and

14 (10) One (1) member appointed by the President Pro Tempore of
15 the Senate.
16

17 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 15-12-101(d), regarding the creation of the
18 Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Council, is amended to read as
19 follows:

20 (d) Members appointed under subdivisions ~~(a)(7) and (8)~~ (a)(6) through
21 (10) of this section who are serving on the effective date of this act shall
22 by lot determine their terms of office so that three (3) of them will serve
23 until July 1, 2005 and the other three (3) will serve until July 1, 2007.
24 Successors shall serve for four-year terms.
