16 TO REQUIRE THE OFFICE OF MOTOR VEHICLE
17 TO REVIEW THE WAIVER OF DRIVER'S LICENSE

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-16-804(b), concerning the issuance of
25 driver's license with restrictions and the waiver of age restrictions, is
26 amended to read as follows:

27 (b)(1) The office may either issue a special restricted license or may
28 set forth such restrictions upon the usual license form.

29 (2)(A) The office may, upon a showing of need, waive any age
30 restriction set forth in this chapter.

31 (B) The waiver of the age restrictions for need is subject
32 to review upon a complaint from certain officials under subsection (d) of
33 this section.

35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-16-804(d), concerning the revocation of
36 a restricted driver's license, is amended to read as follows:

1 (d)(1) The office may, upon receiving satisfactory evidence of any
2 violation of the restrictions of a license, suspend or revoke it, but the
3 licensees shall be entitled to a hearing as upon a suspension or revocation
4 under this chapter.

5 (2)(A) Upon receiving a complaint from a prosecuting attorney, a
6 city attorney, or a certified law enforcement officer, the office shall
7 review the validity of any waiver of age restrictions based on need.

8 (B) The licensee is entitled to a hearing to review the
9 need of the waiver and the complaining official may attend.

10 (C) The office shall suspend or revoke the waiver if there
11 is evidence that the need for the waiver has changed or is no longer valid.
