11 HIGHWAYS 378 AND 96 IN SCOTT AND SEBASTIAN
12 COUNTIES AS THE "POTEAU MOUNTAIN SCENIC HIGHWAY",
13 AND PART OF STATE HIGHWAY 10 IN SEBASTIAN COUNTY
14 AS THE "SUGARLOAF MOUNTAIN SCENIC HIGHWAY", AND
15 TO MAKE THEM ARKANSAS SCENIC HIGHWAYS; AND FOR
16 OTHER PURPOSES.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
27

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-67-203(a), concerning the designation of
29 portions of certain highways as Arkansas scenic highways, is amended to add
30 two (2) additional subdivisions to read as follows:

31 (48) State 378 from its intersection with U.S. 71 in Scott County,
32 south and east of Mansfield, westward until it intersects with State 96, west
33 of Mansfield in Sebastian County; then along State 96 westward until reaching
34 the eastern corporate limits of Hartford in Sebastian County, which will be
35 known as the "Poteau Mountain Scenic Highway", an Arkansas Scenic Highway;
36 and



1 (49) State 10 from the western corporate limits of Greenwood in
2 Sebastian County, then westward along State 10 until reaching the Oklahoma
3 state boundary, which will be known as the "Sugarloaf Mountain Scenic
4 Highway", an Arkansas Scenic Highway.
