- 11 (a)(1) Illegal dumps control officers are hereby empowered to ensure 12 compliance with the provisions of this subchapter by having the right and 13 duty to:
- 14 (A) Inspect suspected illegal dumps;
- 15 (B) Collect evidence of open dumping <u>and littering</u> and 16 present the evidence to the prosecuting attorney or a court of competent 17 jurisdiction where the offense was committed; and
- 18 (C) Issue and serve citations for violations of provisions
 19 of the Arkansas Solid Waste Management Act, § 8-6-201 et seq., prohibiting
