23 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. POSITION 24 25 TRANSFER. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer, the State Office of 26 Emergency Services Arkansas Department of Emergency Management is hereby 27 authorized to transfer positions between appropriations as may be required 28 should a disaster occur which results in a Presidential Disaster Proclamation 29 and/or when an employee occupies one position which is to be paid from two or more appropriations during a single fiscal year. The provisions of this 30 31 section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 July 1, 2003 through June 32 30, 2003 June 30, 2005.

LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 9 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 11 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 12 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 13 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 14 15 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 16 17 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.
