28	SECTION 1. Arkan	sas Code § 24-10-102(15), concer	rning the definitions
29	used in the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System, is amended to		
30	read as follows:		
31	(15)(A) "Final a	verage pay" means the monthly av	verage of the pays to
32	an employee during the period of thirty-six (36) consecutive months of		
33	credited service producing the highest monthly average, but the period must		
34	be contained within the period of one hundred twenty (120) consecutive months		
35		nediately preceding his or her se	eparation from covered
36	employment.

1	(B) Should a member have fewer than thirty-six (36) months		
2	of credited service, "final average pay" means the monthly average of pays t		
3	him or her during his or her total months of credited service.		
4	(C) In any event, pays usable in determining final average		
5	pay shall be limited by the following test, considering the final average pay		
6	period in four (4) contiguous segments: Pays during any one (1) annual		
7	segment shall be usable only to the extent that the pays do not exceed		
8	thirty-one percent (31%) of the total pays in the final average pay period,		
9	but if the final average pay period is less than four (4) full years, the		
10	maximum usable thirty-one percent (31%) shall be increased proportionately;		
11	(D) For the limited purposes of calculating final average		
12	pay for disability retirement benefits under § 24-10-607, pay shall include		
13	workers' compensation benefits received by the member.

15	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-10-607(b)(1), concerning disability		
16	retirement benefits for members of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire		
17	Retirement System, is amended to read as follows:		
18	(b)(1) $\underline{(A)}$ Upon disability retirement as provided in subsection (a) of		
19	this section, a member shall receive an annuity provided for in § 24-10-602.		
20	(B)(i) For purposes of calculating the amount of an		
21	annuity for disability retirement, a member's final average pay shall include		
22	workers' compensation benefits received by the member as set forth under		
23	§ 24-10-102(15)(D).		
24	(ii) Disability benefits awarded to members, prior		
25	to the effective date of this subdivision (b)(1)(B), shall be adjusted to		
26	include workers' compensation benefits in calculating final average pay upon		
27	application to the system by the affected member.		
28	(iii) No adjustment shall be made in monthly		
29	benefits paid before January 1, 2003.
