4	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-11-825, concerning pensions for retired
5	volunteer fire fighters under a firemen's pension and relief fund, is amended
6	to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
7	(c) Upon a member's termination of volunteer fire fighter service with
8	all Arkansas departments for a period of not less than ninety (90) days, the
9	member may return to volunteer service with an employer covered by a
10	firemen's pension and relief fund, and may continue to draw the retiree's
11	pension if the retiree desires to return to volunteer service with an
12	employer covered by a pension fund, and voluntarily agrees to sign a waiver
13	to earning any further service credit in the pension fund.
