5	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-11-825, concerning pensions for retired
6	volunteer fire fighters under a firemen's pension and relief fund, is amended
7	to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
8	(c) Upon a member's termination of volunteer fire fighter service with
9	all Arkansas departments for a period of not less than ninety (90) days, the
10	member may return to volunteer service with an employer covered by a
11	firemen's pension and relief fund, and may continue to draw the retiree's
12	pension if the retiree desires to return to volunteer service with an
13	employer covered by a pension fund, and voluntarily agrees to sign a waiver
14	to earning any further service credit in the pension fund.
