> AN ACT TO AMEND § $9(\mathrm{~b})$ OF AMENDMENT 51 TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION REGARDING THE APPLICATION TO REGISTER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO AMEND § 9 (b) OF AMENDMENT 51
TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Under the authority granted in $\S 19$ of Amendment 51 to the Arkansas Constitution, §9(b) of Amendment 51 to the Arkansas Constitution, regarding the application to register, is amended to read as follows:
(b)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (b)(2) of this section, Registration registration shall be in progress at all times except during the thirty-day period immediately prior to any election scheduled within the county, during which period registration of voters shall cease for that election, but registration during such period shall be effective for subsequent elections.
(2) If a voter moves from one county to another, the voter may transfer his or her registration at any time and is not required to reregister upon moving within the state.
(3) Upon notification of the voter's new address, the county registrar shall verify the voter's status from the statewide voter file and update the voter's address.
(4) After the voter's address is updated, the voter shall be a registrant of the new county of residence.






(5) All voter history shall follow the transferring registrant from the statewide voter file.
