3	SECTION 2. (a) Beginning July 1, 2003, Arkansas Code § 24-10-
4	607(d)(2) shall apply retroactively to allow Arkansas Local Police and Fire
5	Retirement System members who received a disability retirement before July 1,
6	2001, to receive the greater benefit of sixty-five percent (65%) of the final
7	average salary of the member or an amount equal to the annuity paid to
8	retirants for each year of paid service resulting from employment.
9	(b) However, the system shall not be responsible for making benefit
10	payments retroactive to the effective date of the disability.
11	
12	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
13	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain individuals under the
14	Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System were injured and disabled in
15	the actual performance of duties as an employee before July 1, 2001; that
16	those members did not receive the advantage of the benefit increase of Act
17	1132 of 2001; that this inequity has worked a financial hardship on
18	individuals who were injured before the benefit was given to those members
19	after July 1, 2001; and that those individuals who were not granted benefits
20	under that law should have benefits restored as soon as possible and to have
21	this act applied retroactively. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist
22	and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health
23	and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2003.
