## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MINIMUM BENEFIT PAID TO VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTERS UNDER A LOCAL FIRE PENSION AND RELIEF FUND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MINIMUM BENEFIT PAID TO VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTERS UNDER A LOCAL FIRE PENSION AND RELIEF FUND.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-11-807(a), concerning the minimum payments under the fire pension and relief funds, is amended to read as follows:
(a)(1)(A) For volunteer fire fighters, in no case shall the payment to any retired member be less than fifty dollars ( $\$ 50.00$ ) one hundred dollars ( $\$ 100$ ) per month, and the payment shall be made in accordance with the justice and equity of each case as determined by the board of trustees of the firemen's relief and pension fund.
(B) The benefits provided for in this subdivision (a)(1) shall only be paid provided the retirement funds are actuarially sound after the increase as determined by the actuary for the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Review Board.
(2) In no case shall the payment to any retired member be less than thirty dollars ( $\$ 30.00$ ) per month, and the payment shall be made in accordance with the justice and equity of each case as determined by the

## board of trustees of the firemen's relief and pension fund.
