20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 27, Subchapter 2 is amended
23 to add an additional section to read as follows:

24 5-27-230. Exposure of child to a chemical substance or
25 methamphetamine.

26 (a) For purposes of this section:

27 (1)(A) "Chemical substance" means a substance intended to be
28 used as a precursor in the manufacture of methamphetamine, or any other
29 chemical intended to be used in the manufacture of methamphetamine.

30 (B) Intent may be demonstrated by the substance's use,
31 quantity, manner of storage, or proximity to other precursors or equipment
32 used to manufacture methamphetamine;

33 (2) "Child" means any person under the age of eighteen (18)
34 years; and

35 (3) "Methamphetamine" has the same meaning as provided in the
36 Uniform Controlled Substances Act, § 5-64-101 et seq.
