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23	SECTION 1. (a)	The Department of Education is d	ivided into two (2)

- system in Arkansas at the state and district level, which will include an 1 2 analysis of the level of adequacy and equity of the educational opportunity in all school districts; 3 4 (C) Verify the accuracy of reports of school, district, 5 and state performance by conducting, requesting, or upon the approval of the 6 State Board of Education, contracting for periodic program and fiscal audits 7 as necessary. The Department of Accountability shall monitor and verify the accuracy of reports of the Department of Education and the State Board of 8 9 Education, including but not limited to the annual fiscal conditions of 10 grants, categorical programs, and other educational initiatives set forth by 11 the General Assembly; 12 (D) Conduct studies, analyze, verify, and validate the 13 state assessment program through other external indicators of academic progress, including, but not limited to, American College Test scores, 14 15 Scholastic Assessment Test scores, National Assessment of Education Progress 16 scores, Preliminary Scholastic Assessment Test scores, Advanced Placement 17 Program participation, standardized test scores, college remediation rates, retention and attendance rates, dropout rates, and additional available data 18 19 on the efficiency of the system of schools and whether progress is being made 20 toward attaining the goal of providing all students with the opportunity for 21 an equitable and adequate education; and 22 (E) Make biennial reports to the Governor and the Joint 23 Education Committee of the General Assembly. The first report is due on June 24 1 and the second report due on December 1 of each year. 25 (c) All appropriations, unexpended balances and other assets of the 26 Department of Education shall be divided between the two (2) divisions as 27 determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. 28 (d) All references to the Department of Education in the Arkansas Code 29 shall mean either the Department of Curriculum and Instruction or the 30 Department of Accountability, as determined by the State Board of Education. 31 (e)(1) All rights, duties or functions assigned to the Director of the 32 Department of Education in the Arkansas Code shall be transferred to both the 33 Director of the Department of Curriculum and Instruction and the Director of

Arkansas Code § 6-11-102 is amended to read as follows: 6 6-11-102. Director of the Department of Education- State Board of 7 Education Staff. 8 (a)(1) Subject to confirmation by the Governor, the The State Board of 9 Education is empowered to employ: 10 (A) Shall employ a person to act as the Director of the 11 Department of Education, who Curriculum and Instruction; 12 (B) Shall employ a person to act as the Director of 13 Accountability; and 14 (C)(i) May employ staff to work directly for the board as 15 may be necessary to carry out the functions of the board. 16 (ii) Funding for employees working directly for the 17 board shall be provided from appropriations and funds authorized for the Department of Curriculum and Instruction and the Department of Accountability 18 in proportion to each department's share of the total appropriation and funds 19 20 authorized for both departments for personal services and operating expenses. 21 (2) All persons employed by the board shall serve at the 22 pleasure of the Governor board. 2.3 (b) The Each director shall devote all of his or her time to the 24 duties of his or her office, shall act as an agent of the board, and perform 25 other duties as are designated by the board and by statute. 26 (c)(l) The Each person selected as the a director must: 27 (A) Be a person of good moral character, recognized as a 28 leader in the field of education, and qualified technically and by experience 29 to direct the work of the Department of Education their respective 30 departments; 31 (B) Hold the master's degree from an accredited 32 institution; 33 (C) Have had ten (10) years' experience as a teacher, five 34 (5) of which must be of an administrative or supervisory nature; and 35 (D) Hold a valid state teacher's certificate. 36 (2) No person who is related within the fourth degree of

1 consanguinity or affinity to any member of the board shall be eligible to 2 serve as a director.

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- 3 (d) It is the specific intention of this act to define and declare the 4 each director to be the employee of the State Board of Education.
 - (e)(1) The Each director, or a disbursing agent designated by him or her and approved by the board, shall give bond to the State of Arkansas as provided by law for other disbursing agents conditioned for the faithful performance of his or her duties and the faithful accounting for all the school money of the state, of any county, or of any school district that may come into his or her hands.
- 11 (2) The bond shall be in a solvent surety company having a right 12 to do business in the State of Arkansas and shall be approved by the board.
- 13 (3) The premium on the bond shall be paid by the board as one of the expenses of the board.
- 15 (f) The state shall furnish the each director and the employees of the 16 board with suitable offices and necessary office supplies and equipment.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-11-103 is amended to read as follows: 6-11-103. Officers.

(a) The State Board of Education shall elect one (1) of its number chairman, one (1) vice chairman, and such other officers as the board deems necessary to perfect its organization.

(b) The Director of the Department of Education shall act as ex officio secretary of the board without vote.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-11-104 is amended to read as follows: 6-11-104. Meetings.

- 28 (a) The State Board of Education shall meet a minimum of six (6) times 29 annually.
- 30 (b) The board will meet each December to determine the meeting dates 31 for the following year.
- 32 (c)(1) Special meetings may be called by the chairman of the board
 33 with no less than twenty-four (24) hours notice to the members and the
 34 Director of the Department of Education Curriculum and Instruction, and the
 35 Director of the Department of Accountability, and with timely responses from
 36 enough board members that they will attend the meeting so as to indicate that

- 1 a quorum will be present.
- 2 (2) In the absence of the chairman, the director Director of the
- 3 Department of Curriculum and Instruction or the Director of the Department of
- 4 Accountability shall call a meeting on the request of three (3) members of
- 5 the board with the same notice and response requirements.
- 6 (3) If both the chairman and the director directors shall be
- 7 absent or refuse to call a meeting, any three (3) members of the board may
- 8 call a meeting by utilizing the same notice and response requirements in
- 9 notifying the members and the offices of the director directors.

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- 11 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 6-11-105(b), concerning the powers and
- 12 duties of the State Board of Education, is amended to read as follows:
- 13 (b) The board may organize and, from time to time, change and alter
- 14 the department into branches or sections as may be found necessary and
- 15 desirable by the Director of the Department of Education Curriculum and
- 16 Instruction or the Director of the Director of the Department of
- 17 Accountability to perform all proper functions and to render maximum service
- 18 relating to the operation and improvement of the general education programs
- 19 of the state.

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- 21 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 6-11-110 is amended to read as follows:
- 22 6-11-110. Uniform system of records Reports.
- 23 (a) The State Board of Education shall prescribe a uniform system of
- 24 records to be kept by the school directors, principals, and teachers of
- 25 schools.
- 26 (b) All the school officials and employees listed in subsection (a) of
- 27 this section shall make reports to the Director of the Department of
- 28 Education Accountability as may be designated by the board.

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- 30 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 6-11-111 is amended to read as follows:
- 31 6-11-111. Records of proceedings Annual report.
- 32 (a) The State Board of Education shall keep in the office of the
- 33 Department of Education Curriculum and Instruction a complete record of the
- 34 minutes of its meetings and other proceedings and annually shall make a
- 35 report to the Governor which shall embody the report of the director.
- 36 (b) The annual report of the board to the Governor shall be

1	transmitted by him to the General Assembly at the opening of the session.		
2	(c) Such reports shall be printed by the board and distributed among		
3	the various school officers of the state.

6	6-11-117. Copies of documents as evidence.		
7	Copies of any papers or documents on file in the office of the		
8	Department of Education Director of the Department of Curriculum and		
9	Instruction or the Director of the Department of Accountability authenticated		
10	by him or her with the seal of the State Board of Education shall be		
11	admissible in evidence with the same effect as the original.		
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
