## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to modify the number of ballots a DESIGNATED BEARER MAY PICK UP FOR ANOTHER VOTER AND THE NUMBER OF BALLOTS A DESIGNATED BEARER MAY DELIVER TO THE COUNTY CLERK PER ELECTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE NUMBER OF BALLOTS A DESIGNATED BEARER MAY PICK UP FOR ANOTHER VOTER AND THE NUMBER OF BALLOTS A DESIGNATED BEARER MAY DELIVER TO THE COUNTY CLERK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-5-409(c), concerning materials furnished to qualified voters, is amended to read as follows:
(c)(1) Except for absentee ballots mailed to an address outside the county in which the applicant is registered, an absentee ballot shall be mailed to the address that appears on the applicant's registration record or absentee ballot application if the voter is temporarily at a different address.
(2) The county clerk shall not mail more than five (5) two (2) absentee ballots to the same address unless:
(A) The address is outside the territorial limits of the United States and the District of Columbia;
(B) The address is for a long-term care or residential
care facility licensed by the state;
(C) There are more than five (5) persons lawfully registered at the same address.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-5-409 (f)-(h), concerning materials furnished to qualified voters, is amended to read as follows:
(f) The county clerk shall not provide more than five (5) absentee ballots two (2) absentee ballots per election to any designated bearer, nor shall the county clerk accept delivery of more than five (5) absentee ballots two (2) absentee ballots per election from any designated bearer.
(g) The county clerk shall not deliver in person or by any other means of transmittal more than five (5) absentee ballots two (2) absentee ballots per election to the individual authorized to receive the absentee ballots unless:
(1) There there are more than five (5) persons lawfully registered at the same address as the individual obtaining the absentee ballots, in which case the individual may only receive the same number of absentee ballots as persons lawfully registered at the same address; or.
(2) There are more than five (5) persons lawfully registered at the address for which the designated bearer or authorized agent is obtaining the absentee ballots, in which case the designated bearer may only receive the same number of absentee ballots as persons lawfully registered at the same address.
(h) A designated bearer shall only be allowed to pick up five (5) two (2) absentee ballots from the county clerk per election and shall only be allowed to do so during the fifteen (15) days prior to a preferential or general election and seven (7) days prior to a general primary election.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 7-5-411(a)(2), concerning methods of voting absentee, is amended to read as follows:
(2) (A) By delivery of the ballot to the county clerk of the county of residence of the voter not later than 7:30 p.m. on election day by a relative of the voter, the designated bearer, or the authorized agent of the absentee voter who is medically unable to vote at the regular polling site upon proper verification of the signature of the voter by the county clerk and validation of the identity of the authorized agent.

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(B) (i) The designated bearer, authorized agent, or relative shall sign documentation upon delivery of absentee ballots to the county clerk.
(ii) However, no person may deliver absentee ballots to the clerk's office for more than five (5) two (2) persons; or
