25	25 SECTION 1. (a) There is created on	the books of the Treasurer of	
26	State, Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a special		
27	revenue fund to be known as the "Alternative Fuels Fund".

3	(b) The fund shall consist of that portion of the section 3(a) fees	
4	prescribed in section 3(c)(2).	
5	(c) The fund shall be used by the Department of Human Services to	
6	supplement the Federal Weatherization Assistance Program.	
7	(d)(1) The department may establish a weatherization assistance	
8	program and use the Arkansas Weatherization Assistance Fund to carry out the	
9	program.	
10	(2) The program may include, but is not limited to:	
11	(A) Establishing criteria under which an applicant may	
12	qualify for weatherization assistance;	
13	(B) Defining the weatherization measures which may be	
14	undertaken under the program;	
15	(C) Contracting for weatherization to be performed upon	
16	qualified dwellings;	
17	(D) Making repairs to dwellings so that the dwellings will	
18	qualify for federal weatherization assistance; and	
19	(E) Providing financial literacy training for recipients	
20	of weatherization assistance.	
21	(3) The household income eligibility criteria for assistance	
22	under the program shall be a household income less than two hundred percent	
23	(200%) of the poverty level applicable to the household as determined by the	
24	department.	
25	(4) The Arkansas Department of Human Services may establish	
26	grant agreements with local governments and nonprofit corporations that meet	
27	qualifications to be established by the department.	
28	(5) Grant agreements under this section shall be for the	
29	purposes authorized by this act.

31	SECTION 3. (a)(1) An electric or natural gas utility may elect to	
32	contribute to the Alternative Fuels Fund and the Arkansas Weatherization	
33	Assistance Fund by notifying the Director of the Department of Finance and	
34	Administration in writing.	
35	(2) Each contributing electric utility shall be assessed a fee	
36	of one tenth of a cent (0 lc) per kilowatt hour sold to each residential	

1	customer in this state, but not to exceed one dollar (\$1.00) per customer in	
2	any month.	
3	(3) Each contributing natural gas utility shall be assessed a	
4	fee of one tenth of a cent (0.1¢) per hundred cubic fee sold to each	
5	residential customer in this state, but not to exceed one dollar (\$1.00) per	
6	customer in any month.	
7	(4) A utility may recover the cost of this fee by assessing a	
8	direct charge on each residential customer bill.	
9	(5) The charge shall not be considered a rate or tariffed	
10	service subject to the jurisdiction of the Arkansas Public Service	
11	Commission.	
12	(6) Proceeds from the fee shall not be considered revenue to the	
13	utility for purposes of setting the utility's regulated rates.	
14	(b) By the twentieth (20th) day of each calendar month, the utility	
15	shall remit the amount of the fee recovered during the previous calendar	
16	month to the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration.	
17	(c)(1) The director shall deposit thirty percent (30%) of the amount	
18	remitted by each utility to the State Treasury as special revenues credited	
19	to the Alternative Fuels Fund.	
20	(2) The director shall deposit seventy percent (70%) of the	
21	amount remitted by each utility to the State Treasury as special revenues	
22	credited to the Arkansas Weatherization Assistance Fund.

24	SECTION 4. (a)(1) The Alternative Fuels Commission shall file a	
25	report with the Arkansas Legislative Council by September 15 of each year.	
26	(2) The report shall inform the council as to the grants made	
27	and the results for the period of the previous fiscal year ending on June 30.	
28	(b)(1) The Department of Human Services shall file a report with the	
29	Arkansas Legislative Council by September 15 of each year.	
30	(2) The report shall provide an overview of program activity,	
31	including but not limited to, information on the types of families assisted,	
32	the geographic distribution of assistance, and results of the program.	
33	(3) The report shall address the period of the previous fiscal	
34	year ending on June 30.	
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
