19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE	GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKA	ANSAS:

21	SECTION 1. As	used in this act:	
22	(1) "Gun show promoter" means a person who organizes, plans, promotes,		
23	or operates an organized gun show;		
24	(2) "Gun show	vendor" means a person who exhibits,	sells, offers to
25	sell, transfers, or exchanges a firearm at an organized gun show regardless		
26	of whether the person arranges with a gun show promoter for a fixed location		
27		, sell, offer for sale, transfer, or	exchange any
28	firearm; and		
29	·	gun show" means the entire premises	·
30	including parking areas for the event, if the event is sponsored to foster		
31	the purchase, sale, offer for sale, or collection of firearms and if either		
32	of the following occurs:		
33	(A) Twenty-five (25) or more firearms are offered or exhibited		
34	for sale, transfer, or exchange; or		
35		east three (3) gun show vendors exhib	oit, sell, offer for

2	SECTION 2. (a) Before a gun show vendor may transfer or attempt to		
3	transfer a firearm at an organized gun show, the gun show vendor shall obtain		
4	approval of the transfer from the Department of Arkansas State Police after		
5	the department conducts a background check on the prospective transferee		
6	through the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Instant Criminal		
7	Background Check System.		
8	(b) A gun show promoter shall prominently post a notice, in a form to		
9	$\underline{\text{be prescribed}}$ by the Department of Arkansas State Police, that sets forth $\underline{\text{the}}$		
10	instant background check requirement of this section.		
11	(c) This section does not apply to the transfer of an antique firearm		
12	as defined in 18 USC 921(a)(16) as it existed December 31, 2002, or a curio		
13	or relic as defined in 27 CFR 178.11 as it existed December 31, 2002.		
14	(d) Any gun show vendor or promoter who violates this section is		
15	guilty of a Class B felony.
