9 AN ACT TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MARTIN  
10 LUTHER KING JR. COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER  
11 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

13 AN ACT TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE  
14 MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. COMMISSION.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-24-101(b), concerning the membership of  
21 the commission, is amended to read as follows:

22 (b) The commission shall consist of twenty-six (26) members:

23 (1) A representative of the Governor's Office, to be appointed  
24 by the Governor and to serve at the pleasure of the Governor;

25 (2) Four (4) members to be appointed by and serve at the  
26 pleasure of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;

27 (3) Four (4) members to be appointed by and serve at the  
28 pleasure of the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

29 (4) Thirteen (13) members of the general public, to be appointed  
30 by the Governor, who shall be residents of the state, shall represent the  
31 various geographical areas of the state and various civic, social, religious,  
32 educational, labor, business, and artistic organizations, and shall be  
33 committed to resolving conflict and to upholding the humanitarian philosophy  
34 of Dr. King; and

35 (5)(A) Four (4) members of the general public, to be appointed  
36 by the Governor, who shall be residents of the state between the ages of



1 sixteen (16) and nineteen (19), no more than one (1) of whom shall reside in  
2 the same congressional district.

3 (B) The four (4) members appointed under subdivision  
4 (b)(5)(A) shall be nonvoting advisory members of the commission.

5  
6 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 25-24-101(f), concerning the voting  
7 procedures commission, is amended to read as follows:

8 (f) A majority of the voting members of the commission shall  
9 constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
