10 AN ACT TO PROVIDE MUNICIPAL POLICEMEN AND FIRE
11 FIGHTERS WHO HAVE TEN (10) OR MORE YEARS OF
12 SERVICE AT THE MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT WITH TWENTY
13 (20) DAYS OF ANNUAL VACATION WITH FULL PAY; AND
14 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

17 FIGHTERS WHO HAVE TEN (10) OR MORE YEARS
18 OF SERVICE IN THE CITY DEPARTMENT WITH

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-52-106 is amended to read as follows:
26 14-52-106. Annual vacation.

27 The head or chief of each police department shall arrange that each
28 employee, who has:

29 (1) Less than ten (10) years of service in the police
30 department, shall be granted an annual vacation of not less than fifteen (15)
31 working days with full pay; and

32 (2) Ten (10) or more years of service in the police department,
33 shall be granted an annual vacation of not less than twenty (20) working days
34 with full pay.

36 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-53-107 is amended to read as follows:



1 14-53-107. Annual vacation.

2 The chief of the fire department shall so arrange that each employee,
3 who has:

4 (1) Less than ten (10) years of service in the fire department,
5 shall be granted an annual vacation of not less than fifteen (15) days with
6 full pay; and

7 (2) Ten (10) or more years of service in the fire department,
8 shall be granted an annual vacation of not less than twenty (20) days with
9 full pay.
