Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal 13 Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State 14 15 Treasurer the sum of one million seventy three thousand dollars (\$1,073,000) 16 from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the University of Arkansas 17 at Pine Bluff to provide funds for the appropriation provided herein. 18 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 31 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 32 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act

33 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 34 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 35 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 36 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or

3	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
4	Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
5	the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff are, due to unforeseen
6	circumstances, insufficient for the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff to
7	continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of
8	this act will provide the necessary monies for the University of Arkansas at
9	Pine Bluff to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date
10	of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
11	provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
12	hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
13	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force
14	and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
15	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
16	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
17	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
18	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
19	the veto.
