Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE USING A CELLULAR TELEPHONE, TO LIST CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS, AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE USING A CELLULAR TELEPHONE AND LIST CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS AND PROVIDE A PENALTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 5l, Subchapter 14 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

27-51-1408. Operation of a motor vehicle while using cellular telephone prohibited.
(a) It is unlawful for any person to operate any motor vehicle while using a cellular telephone in the motor vehicle except if the cellular telephone is equipped for hands-free operation and the driver has at least one (l) hand free for use on the vehicle's steering mechanism.
(b) This section does not apply to a driver using the cellular

## telephone:

(1) While the motor vehicle is parked;
(2) To contact law enforcement officials, public safety, emergency medical, fire emergency personnel, or a 911 public safety
communications center to report an emergency situation; or
(3) In the course of performing the driver's official duties as a certified law enforcement officer, fire fighter, ambulance driver, or an emergency medical technician.
(c) A person who violates this section is guilty of a violation and shall be:
(1) Issued a citation for the first offense as a warning, no penalty shall be imposed, and no court appearance shall be required unless the person wishes to contest the offense; and
(2) Fined an amount not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) for any second or subsequent offense.
