24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GE	ENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF A	RKANSAS:
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26	SECTION 1. FUND TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this		
27	act the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and		
28	those of the State Treasurer the unexpended balance of monies remaining in		
29	the Arkansas Real Property Reappraisal Fund on June 30, 2003, as follows:		
30	seventy six percent (76%) of the balance to the Department of Education		
31	Public School Fund Account, sixteen percent (16%) of the balance to the		
32	County Aid Fund, an eight percent (8%) of the balance to the Municipal Aid		
33	Fund.		
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35	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized		
36	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds		

1 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 2 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 3 4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 8 9 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 14 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17 18 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that excess monies in the Arkansas Real Property Reappraisal Fund 19 20 are beyond what is actually needed to pay for the intended obligations of the 21 fund; and that the excess monies transferred from the Department of Education 22 Public School Fund Account, the County Aid Fund and the Municipal Aid Fund to 23 the Arkansas Real Property Reappraisal Fund should be transferred back in 24 order to assist the state in its financial obligation to the public schools, 25 counties and municipalities; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 26 2003 is essential to the operation of the agencies for which the monies 27 transferred by this Act provides, and that in the event of an extension of 28 the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 29 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and 30 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate 31 32 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force 33 and effect from and after July 1, 2003. 34 35

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
