27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-402 is amended to read as follows:

29	(a)(1) The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules and	
30	regulations for the issuance, certification <u>licensure</u> , recertification	
31	relicensure, and continuance of certification licensure of teachers in the

(b) No applicant for initial certification licensure or certification 3 4 licensure in an additional area shall receive a certificate license unless 5 the applicant scores at or above the minimum level set by the board.

(c) All colleges and universities in this state shall report the 7 results of the examinations to the department upon request.

8 (d) The board shall not delegate to any college or university any of 9 the board's powers or duties pertaining to the issuance, certification 10 licensure, recertification relicensure, and continuance of certification 11 licensure of teachers in public schools in this state.

12 (e) The State Board of Education shall waive the examination 13 requirements under subsection (a) of this section for individuals applying 14 for licensure in Arkansas who have a valid out-of-state teaching license and 15 documented teaching experience as required by the rules and regulations 16 promulgated by the State Board of Education.

17 (f) For purposes of this section, "certified teaching license" includes a licensed classroom teacher, administrator, counselor, or 18 19 librarian.

21 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 22 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the state is experiencing a 23 critical shortage of teachers; that recruiting teachers from out of state will help eliminate some of the shortage; and that this act is immediately 24 necessary because the teachers seeking licensure under this act need to be 25 26 licensed in Arkansas before the start of the 2003-2004 school year, and the 27 State Board of Education needs sufficient time to implement a procedure to license teachers from other states. Therefore, an emergency is declared to 28 29 exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the 30 public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on: 31 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor; 32 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, 33 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the

34 bill; or

35 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto. 36

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
