28	(a) All fines a	assessed against and collected from	persons convicted	
29	for infractions of any of the state laws protecting game, fish, fur-bearing			
30	animals, or fresh water mussels shall be paid to the county treasurer or the			
31	municipal court clerk of the county wherein the fine is assessed and			
32	forwarded, as provided, to the Arkansas State Came and Fish Commission county			
33	treasurer where the offense occurred.			
34	(b)(l) The county treasurer or municipal court clerk shall give his			
35	receipt to any person	paying the fine or to any officer o	f the court making	
36	settlement of fines co	ollected.

1	(2)(A) At the end of each four (4) months, in April, August, and		
2	December, county treasurers or municipal court clerks shall file a report an		
3	forward all fines collected under the provisions of this chapter to the		
4	Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission.		
5	(B) The report, filed on forms provided by the Arkansas		
6	State Came and Fish Commission, shall include:		
7	(i) The name of each defendant;		
8	(ii) The court case number;		
9	(iii) The name of the arresting officer; and		
10	(iv) The amount of the fine.		
11	(b) The fines collected by the county treasurer shall go the county		
12	general fund and shall be used by the county solely for conservation and		
13	conservation education within the intent of Amendment 35 of the Arkansas

15	(c) The Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission shall, upon receipt		
16	thereof, deposit the same with the Treasurer of State who shall deposit the
