26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-41-209, concerning fines, fees, and*
29 *costs arising out of convictions of persons violating state laws protecting*
30 *game, fish, and wildlife, is amended by adding an additional subsection to*
31 *read as follows:*

32 *(d) All or any portion of the fine monies deposited as special*
33 *revenues in the Game Protection Fund shall be expended by the Arkansas State*
34 *Game and Fish Commission in the form of grants issued to the Arkansas*
35 *Department of Education for fish and wildlife conservation education and*
36 *other purposes consistent with Amendment 35 of the Arkansas Constitution.*
