9 AN ACT TO REQUIRE CIGARETTE WHOLESALERS AND
10 RETAILERS TO RETAIN INVOICES FOR THREE (3) YEARS;
11 TO MAKE THE INVOICES SUBJECT TO EXAMINATION BY
12 THE DIRECTOR OF THE TOBACCO CONTROL BOARD; TO
13 REQUIRE SPECIFIC INFORMATION IN THE INVOICES FOR
14 THE SALE OF CIGARETTES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 TO REQUIRE CIGARETTE WHOLESALERS AND
17 RETAILERS TO RETAIN INVOICES FOR THREE

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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 4, Chapter 75, Subchapter 7 is amended
25 to add an additional section to read as follows:

26 4-75-715. Invoices.

27 (a)(1) Copies of all invoices for the purchase or sale of any
28 cigarettes shall be retained by each wholesaler and retailer for a period of
29 three (3) years.

30 (2) The invoices shall be subject to examination by the Director
31 of the Tobacco Control Board or his or her authorized agents upon demand at
32 any time during regular business hours.

33 (b) Wholesalers shall supply the retailer with an invoice that states
34 the following information for each sale of cigarettes:

35 (1) The quantity;

36 (2) The kind;



- 1 (3) The date of sale;
- 2 (4) The price; and
- 3 (5) The trade discounts, if any.

4 (c) Retailers shall require that the wholesaler provide an invoice
5 that states the following information at the time of purchase or receipt of
6 cigarettes:

- 7 (1) The quantity;
- 8 (2) The kind;
- 9 (3) The date of sale;
- 10 (4) The price; and
- 11 (5) The trade discounts, if any.

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
