AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT
OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING
OFFICER FOR STATE ASSISTANCE TO VARIOUS
JACKSONVILLE PROGRAMS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER
- STATE ASSISTANCE TO VARIOUS
JACKSONVILLE PROGRAMS GENERAL
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - JACKSONVILLE BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

(A) For State assistance to the Jacksonville Boys and Girls Club, the sum of\$20,000.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - JACKSONVILLE SENIOR CENTER. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:



(A) For State assistance to the Jacksonville Senior Center, the sum of
\$20,000.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - JACKSONVILLE MUSEUM OF MILITARY HISTORY.

There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration
 - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

(A) For State assistance to the Little Rock Air Force Base Historical
 Foundation, Inc. for the Jacksonville Museum of Military History, the sum of
\$10,000.

SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
2 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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4 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
5 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
6 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
7 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
8 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
9 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
10 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
11 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
12 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
13 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
14 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
