## Subtitle

14 TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 20-22-901  
15 REGARDING THE DUTY OF VOLUNTEER FIRE  
16 DEPARTMENTS TO RESPOND TO REPORTS OF  
17 UNCONTROLLED FIRES.  
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-22-901(a) is amended to read as follows:

24 (a)(1) Upon receipt of a report of an uncontrolled fire or a 911 or  
25 other emergency call reporting a fire, it shall be the duty of volunteer fire  
26 departments operating within the State of Arkansas to respond to, attempt to  
27 control, and put out all fires occurring within their respective districts  
28 involving any real or personal property, whether that property is owned by  
29 members ~~or by nonmembers~~ of the fire district.

30 (2) However, unless ~~a fire is in violation of a countywide fire~~  
31 ~~ban or as may be otherwise provided in an agreement between a nonmember owner~~  
32 ~~of forested lands, cut-over lands, brush lands, or grasslands and a volunteer~~  
33 ~~fire department~~ the following circumstances exist, the volunteer fire  
34 department shall have no duty or authority to respond to or attempt to  
35 control and put out any fire which occurs on forest lands, cut-over lands,  
36 brush lands, or grasslands owned by a nonmember ~~and which does not pose an~~



~~immediate threat to life or to the real or personal property of a person or entity other than the owner of the land on which the fire occurs.:~~

(A) The fire poses an immediate threat to life of any person;

(B) There is a written agreement between a nonmember owner of the real or personal property and the volunteer fire department requiring the fire department to respond;

(C) The fire is in violation of a countywide fire ban; or

(D) The fire poses an immediate threat to the real or personal property owned by a member of the district.

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
