## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO SEPARATE THE OFFICE OF COUNTY AND  
11 CIRCUIT CLERK IN PIKE COUNTY, ARKANSAS; AND FOR  
12 OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

15 TO SEPARATE THE OFFICE OF COUNTY AND  
16 CIRCUIT CLERK IN PIKE COUNTY, ARKANSAS.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20  
21 SECTION 1. (a) Beginning January 1, 2005, the offices of County Clerk  
22 and Circuit Clerk of Pike County shall be separate offices.

23 (b)(1) At the regular November 2004 general election, the qualified  
24 electors of Pike County shall elect a county clerk and a circuit clerk to  
25 hold separate offices under this act and each officer elected shall take  
26 office January 1, 2005.

27 (2) The separate officers shall be elected and qualified as  
28 other county officers and shall hold the office for a term of two (2) years.

29  
30 SECTION 2. (a) The County Clerk and the Circuit Clerk of Pike County  
31 shall each receive compensation as determined by the Quorum Court of Pike  
32 County within the minimum and maximum ranges prescribed by law, and shall  
33 hire other deputies and be entitled to other allowances as authorized by the  
34 Quorum Court of Pike County.

35 (b) The Circuit Clerk and the County Clerk in Pike County shall each  
36 give bond for the faithful performance of the duties of the offices.
